

英語聴解力考査 (EAT)

聴解力考査の指示

1. 聴解力の考査は、PART I II, III, IV の 4 つの部分からなっています。
2. PART I では約 300 語のテキストが読まれます。その内容にもとづいて問題用紙に書かれている問いに答えてください。
3. PART II は会話をきいて質問に答えるものです。質問は口頭でなされますので、それに対する答えを選んでください。
4. PART III では 6 つの短いテキストが読まれます。それぞれについて問題用紙に書かれている問いに答えてください。
5. PART IV は図をみながら約 700 語の説明をきき、その内容について問題用紙に書かれている問いに答えるものです。
6. 各 PART を始める前に詳しい説明がありますので、注意して聞いてください。
7. 各問いには四つの答えが与えられています。その中から最も適当と思うものを一つだけ選び、解答用カードの相当欄を鉛筆でぬってください。

これから考査を始めますが、PART I には 1 番から 6 番までの問題があります。まず、1 分の間それらの問題に目を通します。そのあと、約 300 語の「話し」を聞きます。メモをとる場合は、問題用紙の余白を使ってください。

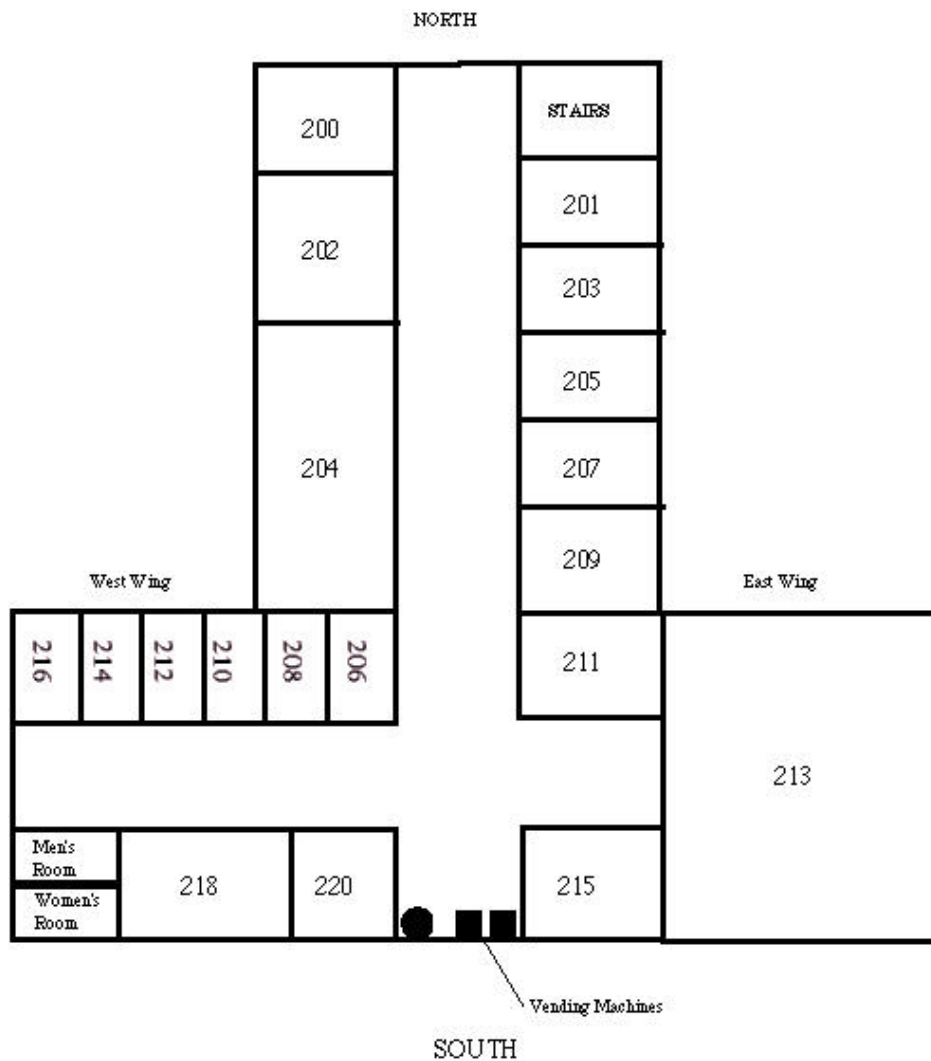
